Please use this document as a guideline for what you can and can not put in your recycling bin. If you are unsure we encourage you to give us a call and we will assist or seek the answers to your questions as soon as possible.

Items that can be recycled:

- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminium and steel cans, foil trays
- Plastic milk, juice, soft drink and detergent bottles with codes
- Ice cream, margarine, yoghurt and any plastic container with codes
- Milk and juice cartons
- Cardboard boxes (flattened)
- Telephone books, work and school papers
- Letters, envelopes, advertising material, newspapers and magazines

Handy recycling hints

Crush plastic bottles, cans and cartons and flatten cardboard to save space.

Rinse containers to prevent smells. Use your leftover washing up water.

Place items in loose. No plastic bags can be recycled!

NO! NOT IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN

- ✗ Nappies
- ✗ Liquids or chemicals
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Pyrex, cups or crockery
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Syringes
- ✗ Soil or dirt
- ✗ Household garbage
- ✗ Waxed cardboard
- ✗ Bottle tops

These items go in your garbage bin

General rubbish, meat, nappies (wrapped), soiled paper (eg. pizza boxes)

Polystyrene

Window glass, Pyrex and light globes (wrapped)

Plastic wrap and plastic bags
